# **Registration**

Online registration opens Monday, January 7, 2019 by going to [www.nepresbyterian.org/womensconference](http://www.nepresbyterian.org/womensconference).

Register by January 31<sup>st</sup> and receive the early-bird registration fee of \$35. After January 31<sup>st</sup>, registration is \$45. High school and college students can register for \$25. All registration fees are non-refundable.

## **Details**

**Hotel Accommodations:** If you are traveling from out of town and need hotel accommodations, we have reserved a block of rooms at the Hilton Garden Inn on Farrow Road.

The rate for these rooms is two queen beds for \$124 and one king bed for \$109 plus any state and local taxes. A continental breakfast is included in this rate. To make a reservation you can call **1-803-807-9000** and reference Northeast Presbyterian Church Women's Conference when making the reservation. To get this special rate, reservations must be made by January 22, 2019. Check in is 3:00 pm on February 22, and check out is by noon on February 23. If you need to cancel your reservation, it must be done so 24 hours prior to arrival.

**Meals:** There will NOT be a meal provided on Friday evening; there are a variety of restaurants within a short driving distance of the church. Upon registration, a list

of nearby restaurants will be provided if you would like to plan to get dinner nearby before the conference starts on Friday.

Water bottles will be provided; please keep in mind that water bottles with a lid are the only beverages permitted in the sanctuary. Coffee will be provided Saturday morning.

We are offering three lunch options for Saturday: a turkey wrap, a gluten free turkey wrap, or a vegetarian wrap (hummus & vegetables). Lunch includes an apple, chips, dessert, and tea or water. Your lunch preference can be selected on the registration page.

**Heart Prep/Prayer Walk:** For seven days before the conference begins, all registrants will receive a short email with scriptures and prayer. We pray that the Lord would use this time each morning leading up to the retreat to prepare your heart for the work the Lord wants to accomplish during the conference.

On Friday at 4:00pm, you are invited to attend an optional prayer walk at Northeast Presbyterian Church to pray for the details of the conference and each woman registered. Please indicate on the registration form if you are interested in attending and details will follow.
