- 4. Interpretation Question Was Paul mostly about theology? How did he live out his faith in the book of Philemon?
- 5. **Reflection Question** FF Bruce write, "What the letter to Philemon does is to bring the institution of slavery into an atmosphere where it could only wilt and die." What are some other areas in our culture that still need the transforming power of the gospel to do the same?
- 6. **Application Question** Josh said, "Where others see obstacles, faith sees opportunities." What opportunities has God put in front of you and your life group to help make this world a better place?
