Questions:

- 3. Have you ever thought of your own identity as being a "glory bearer" of the King? How might things change if we saw one another through this lens?
- 4. How might our prayers and choices change if we truly believed in "the furious longing of God" for those who have never heard of Him?
- 5. How does the incomparably great power of God motivate you to live for His glory above all with enduring joy?
- 6. Are you willing to trust Him with everything, absolutely everything, no matter where He calls you to go, or what He may ask you to do?
