Scripture text: Psalm 143

Outline:

1. HOW: Let me hear
2. WHEN: In the morning
3. WHAT: Of your steadfast love



Questions:

1. What is the life context of Psalm 143? What's David experiencing in life as he writes it?
2. How does David's hardships make his prayer in Psalm 143:8a all the more meaningful?
3. David prays, "let me hear." What can sometimes be the difference between reading a truth on the page of our Bibles and "hearing" it in our hearts? How do you know the difference?
4. What are ways that God helps us get his Word from the Bible page and into our hearts and lives?
5. What's significant about David asking to hear from God "in the morning" as opposed to any other time?
6. How would you define God's "steadfast love"? What are other Scriptures that come to mind when you think of his love?
7. How could Psalm 143:8a be incorporated into a morning routine? How might we use it daily? What would that look like?
